## State Boards of Optometry Approvals

- **Idaho Board of Optometrist** – Approved. *Please contact the Bureau at [opt@ibol.idaho.gov](mailto:opt@ibol.idaho.gov) to clarify any special conditions attached to acceptance.*
- **Kansas Board of Examiners in Optometry** – Approved. The Board accepts COPE approved courses – 40 hours of general optometry, 90 hours of pharmacology, and 53 hours of practice management continuing education. *Please contact the Kansas Board directly to clarify any special conditions attached to acceptance.*
- **Kentucky Board of Optometric Examiners** – The Kentucky Board of Optometric Examiners will only accept the courses being sponsored by SUNY (State University of New York, College of Optometry) for license renewal. Vision Expo Optometry courses are sponsored by the New England College of Optometry. *Please contact the KY board directly to clarify any special conditions attached to acceptance.*
- **Louisiana Board of Optometry** – The Board does not accept COPE approved courses. *Please contact the LA board directly.*
- **Oklahoma Board of Optometry** – Vision Expo is not an approved provider of CE. Vision Expo CE courses are not approved by the State Optometry Board of Oklahoma. *Please contact the OK Board directly to clarify.*
- **South Carolina Board of Optometry** – The Board does not automatically accept COPE courses.
